### **Warren County Board of Supervisors Appoints Interim County Administrator**

February 11, 2026 - The Warren County Board of Supervisors has appointed Dr. David Martin as Interim County Administrator for the County of Warren. Dr. Martin will begin serving in the role on Tuesday, February 17, 2026, providing leadership and continuity of operations while the Board conducts a search for the County's next permanent County Administrator.

Dr. Martin brings a broad range of public service experience to Warren County. He previously served as an elected Supervisor in Henry County, Virginia, giving him firsthand knowledge of local government operations, policy development, and community engagement. In addition, Dr. Martin has an extensive background in public education leadership, having served as a School Superintendent, where he led large organizations, managed complex budgets, and worked collaboratively with governing bodies, staff, and community stakeholders.

In his interim role, Dr. Martin will work closely with County staff and the Board of Supervisors to manage the budget process, ensure organizational stability, and steady leadership during this transition period.

"The Board of Supervisors is confident that Dr. Martin's experience in both local government and executive leadership will help guide the County during this important transition," said Cheryl Cullers, Chair of the Warren County Board of Supervisors. "His collaborative approach and commitment to public service will support our staff, our residents, and our ongoing initiatives."

Dr. Martin expressed his appreciation for the opportunity to serve Warren County during this time. "I am honored to have been selected to serve the Warren County community again," said Dr. Martin. "I believe the Warren County community is in the process of becoming something great. This greatness is only possible through strong communication and collaboration skills. I experienced these two qualities in the school division when I was the Acting Superintendent and now, I know the same culture exists in the county. I welcome the opportunity to work in a community that shows upward mobility."
